### PROFESSIONAL ETHICS AND CODE OF CONDUCT IN EDUCATION

We, at Smt.Sushiladevi Deshmukh College of Arts, Science & Commerce, are committed to follow the following Ethical Practices in the best interest of all the stakeholders,

#### **Code of Conduct for Teachers**

### I. Teachers and their Responsibilities:

Every teacher assumes certain obligation towards the ideal profession. A teacher constantly under the scrutiny of his students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should maintain balance between his precepts and practice. The teacher should be calm, should have patience with positive attitude.

#### **Teachers should:**

- 1. The mission of the institution should be known by all the faculties and the institutional plan should be properly practiced
- 2. Faculty should honesty, integrity, and transparency in all professional interactions.
- 3. Seek to make professional growth continuous through study and research.
- 4. Express free and frank opinion by participation at professional meetings, seminars, conferences etc. towards the contribution of knowledge.
- 5. Maintain active membership of professional organizations and strive to improve education and profession through them.
- 6. Perform their duties in the form of teaching, tutorial, practical, seminar and research work continuously and with dedication.
- 7. The faculty members should take up educational responsibilities of the college and the University such as: assisting in appraising applications for admission, advising and counselling students as well as assisting the conduct of University and college examinations, including supervision, invigilation and evaluation
- 8. Participate in extension, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities including community service.

## II. Teachers and Students

### Teachers should:

- 1. Recognize the difference in aptitude and capabilities among students and strive to meet their individual needs.
- 2. Maintain appropriate boundaries with students to prevent any potential harm or
- 3. Inculcate among student's scientific outlook and respect for physical labour and ideals of democracy, patriotism and peace.
- 4. Be affectionate to the students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason.
- 5. Assess the students on the basis of their performance.
- 6. Help and guide the students even after class hours.

# III. Teachers and Colleagues

### Teachers should:

- 1. Treat other members of the profession in the same manner as they themselves wish to
- 2. Speak respectfully of other teachers and render assistance for professional betterment.
- 3. Refrain from lodging unsubstantiated allegations against colleagues to higher authorities: and
- 4. Refrain from allowing considerations of caste, creed, religion, race or sex in their professional endeavour.

# IV. Teachers and Authorities:

# Teachers should:

- 1. Discharge their professional responsibilities according to the existing rules and adhere to procedures and methods consistent with their profession in initiating steps through their own institutional bodies and / or professional organizations for change of any such rule detrimental to the professional interest.
- 2. Co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution by accepting various offices and discharge responsibilities which such offices may demand.
- 3. Give and expect due notice before a change of position is made and
- 4. Refrain from availing themselves of leave except on unavoidable ground and a far as practicable with prior intimation, keeping in view their particular responsibility for completion of academic schedule.

# V. Teachers and Non-Teaching Staff:

- 1. Teachers should treat the non-teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners in a cooperative undertaking within every educational institution and
- Teachers should help in the function of joint staff-councils covering both teachers and the nonteaching staff.

### VI. Teachers and Guardians:

#### Teachers should:

Try to see through teacher's bodies and organizations that institutions maintain contact with the guardians, their students, send reports of their performance to the guardians whenever necessary and meet the guardians in meetings convened for the purpose for mutual exchange of ideas and for the benefit of the institution.

## Code of Conduct for Students

- 1. Treat all individuals with kindness, respect, and consideration, regardless of their background, race, gender, religion, or abilities.
- Students are expected to obtain clearance from the College before the University examination on the basis of their attendance record and participation in the activities of the college.
- 3. Students not attending classes for more than four consecutive weeks must inform the
- 4. Principal/Teacher in charge in writing or else their names shall be struck off the rolls of the College.
- Application for leave is to be made on advance and submitted to the principal in case of illness, application for leave along with a medical certificate.
- 6. Students must carry their Identity card in college.
- 7. Attend classes, lectures, and other academic commitments regularly and punctually.
- Communicate in advance with instructors if you cannot attend a class or meet a deadline due to valid reasons.
- Complete assignments and exams honestly and independently, without plagiarism, cheating, or unauthorized assistance.
- 10. Engage in open and respectful communication with peers, instructors, and staff.
- 11. Dress in a manner that is appropriate and respectful for the learning environment.
- 12. Participate in extracurricular activities with a positive and inclusive attitude.
- 13. Familiarize yourself with the college policies, rules, and regulations and adhere to them at all times.
- 14. Violations of this code of conduct may result in disciplinary actions, which can include warnings, counselling, probation, suspension, or even expulsion, depending on the severity and frequency of the violation.
