An Alumni of Placement students also formed in Current year , in order to be in touch with ex- students placed in different organizations & also to have good network with these students.

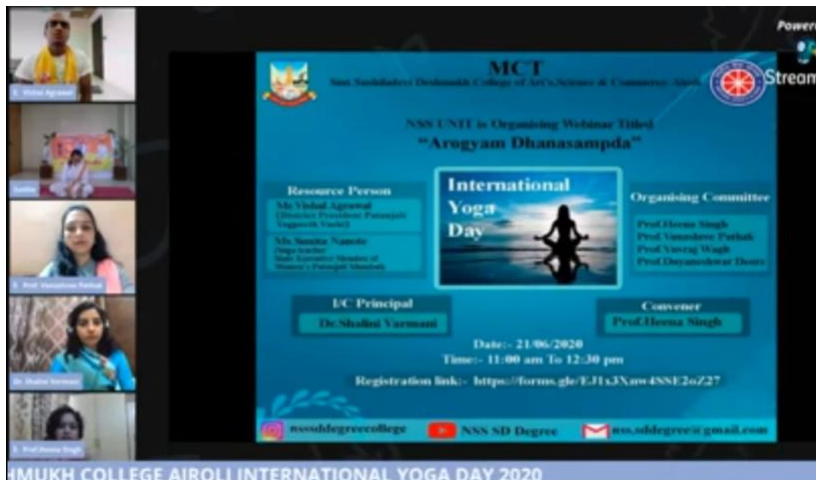
